5 MILE RADIUS SUMMARY 2010



The population in this area is estimated to change from 210,803 to 211,392, resulting in a growth of 0.3% between 2000 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by 2.8%. The current year median age for this area is 37.6, while the average age is 38.0. Five years from now, the median age is projected to be 39.1.



The number of households in this area is estimated to change from 85,354 to 87,415, resulting in an increase of 2.4% between 2000 and the current year. Over the next five years, the number of households is projected to increase by 4.0%.



The average household income is estimated to be \$69,861 for the current year, while the average household income for the United States is estimated to be \$71,071 for the same time frame. The current year estimated per capita income for this area is \$29,159, compared to an estimate of \$27,034 for the United States as a whole.



For this area, 52.9% of the population is estimated to be employed and age 16 and over for the current year. The employment status of this labor force is as follows: 1.5% are in the Armed Forces, 64.6% are employed civilians, 3.9% are unemployed civilians, and 30.0% are not in the labor force. For this area, 52.9% of the population is estimated to be employed and age 16 and over for the current year. The occupational classifications are as follows: 14.0% have occupation type blue collar, 69.2% are white collar, and 16.8% are Service & farm workers. For the civilian employed population age 16 and over in this area, it is estimated that they are employed in the following occupational categories: 3.2% are in Architecture and Engineering, 2.6% are in Arts, Entertainment and Sports, 5.6% are in Business and Financial Operations, 5.7% are in Computers and Mathematics, 6.7% are in Education, Training and Libraries, 5.0% are in Healthcare Practitioners and Technicians, 1.8% are in Healthcare Support, 1.0% are in Life, Physical and Social Sciences, 11.3% are in Management, 13.9% are in Office and Administrative Support. 2.0% are in Community and Social Services, 6.8% are in Food Preparation and Serving, 0.9% are in Legal Services, 2.1% are in Protective Services, 11.4% are in Sales and Related Services, 3.1% are in Personal Care Services. 2.9% are in Building and Grounds Maintenance, 4.8% are in Construction and Extraction, 0.1% are in Farming, Fishing and Forestry, 2.6% are in Maintenance and Repair, 3.3% are in Production, 3.4% are in Transportation and Moving.



Currently, it is estimated that 12.6% of the population age 25 and over in this area had earned a Master's Degree, 2.0% had earned a Professional School Degree, 1.3% had earned a Doctorate Degree and 24.9% had earned a Bachelor's Degree.



Most of the dwellings in this area (63.0%) are estimated to be Owner-Occupied for the current year. For the entire country the majority of the housing units are Owner-Occupied (66.8%). The majority of housing units in this area (23.3%) are estimated to have been Housing Unit Built 1970 to 1979 for the current year.
